#### SESSION-1

- Ms. Arshdeep Kour acquainted students with the introduction and basic concept of ECCE by introducing various charts, drafts, and activities. She started her lecture with a booster round, that included various activities.

Later, she ended her session by orchestrating a quiz.



  onwards.




JAMMU, June 22: In an attempt to implement NEP 2020, Government College of Education, Jammu organized a value added course in Early Child Care Education (ECCE).
