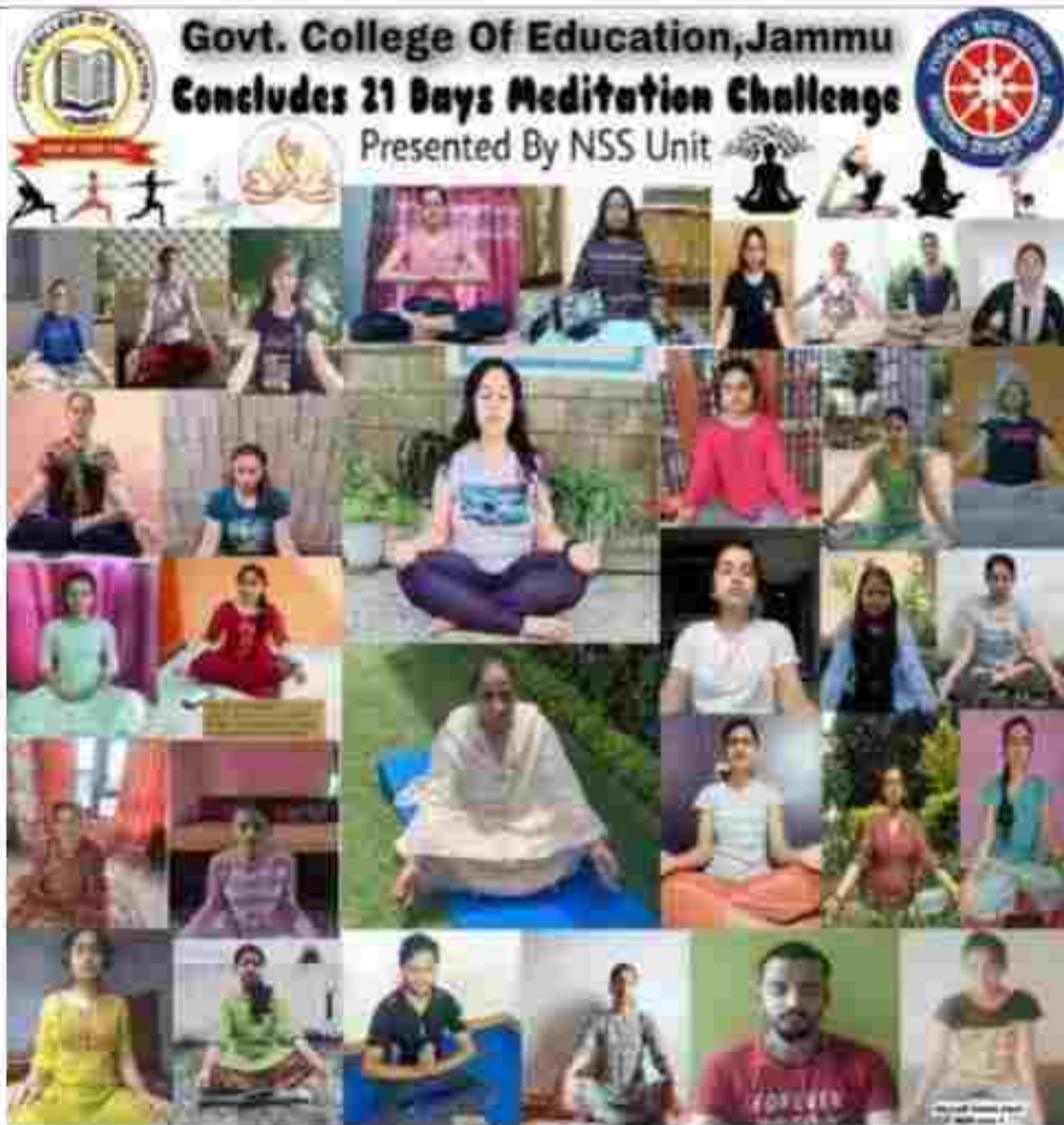


Report on Young Warrior Movement:

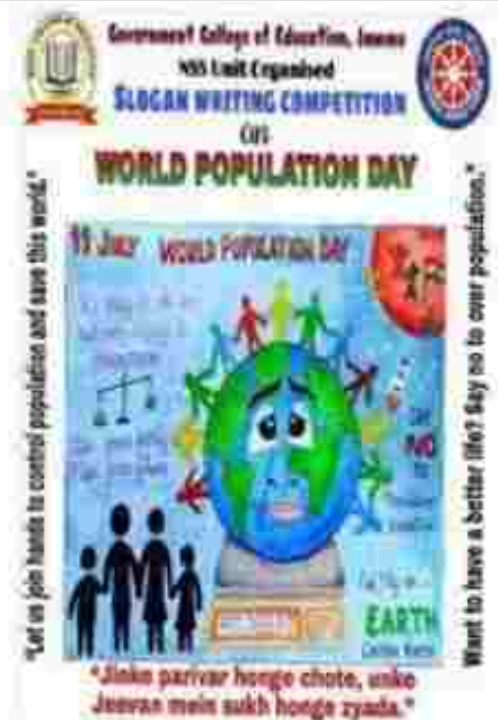


Report on Van Mahotsav:

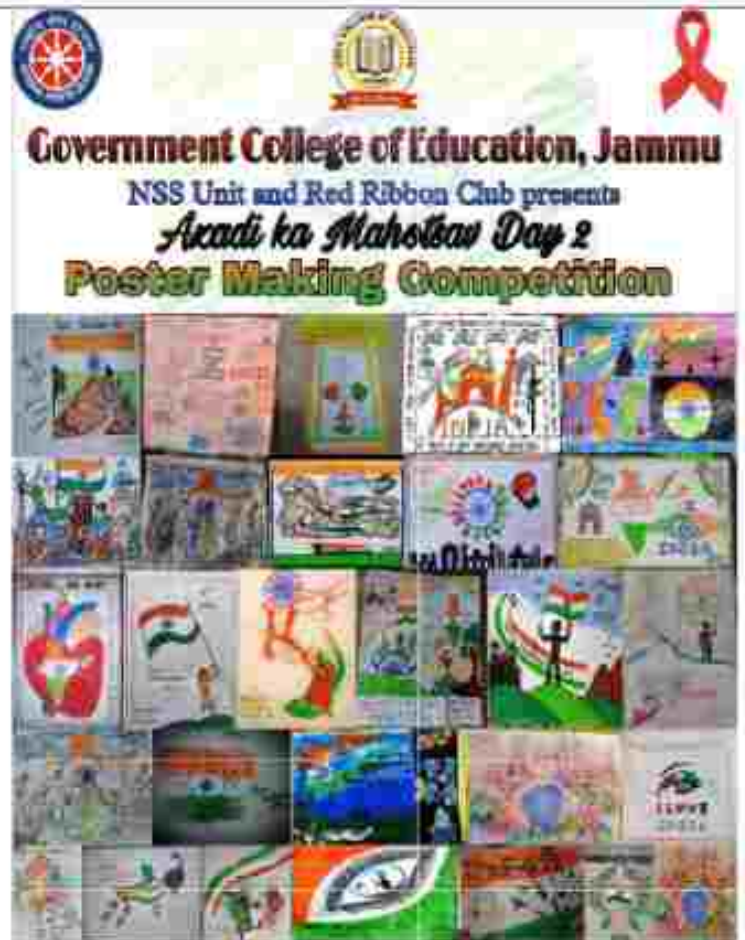


Report on Slogan Making Competition:

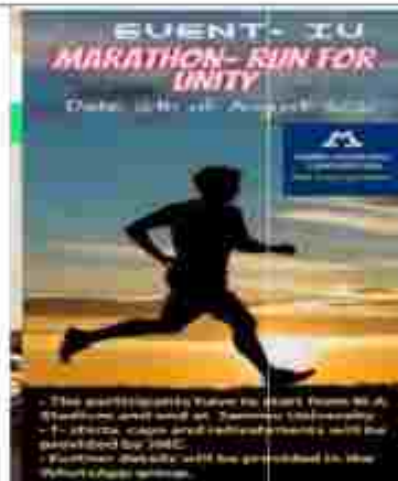

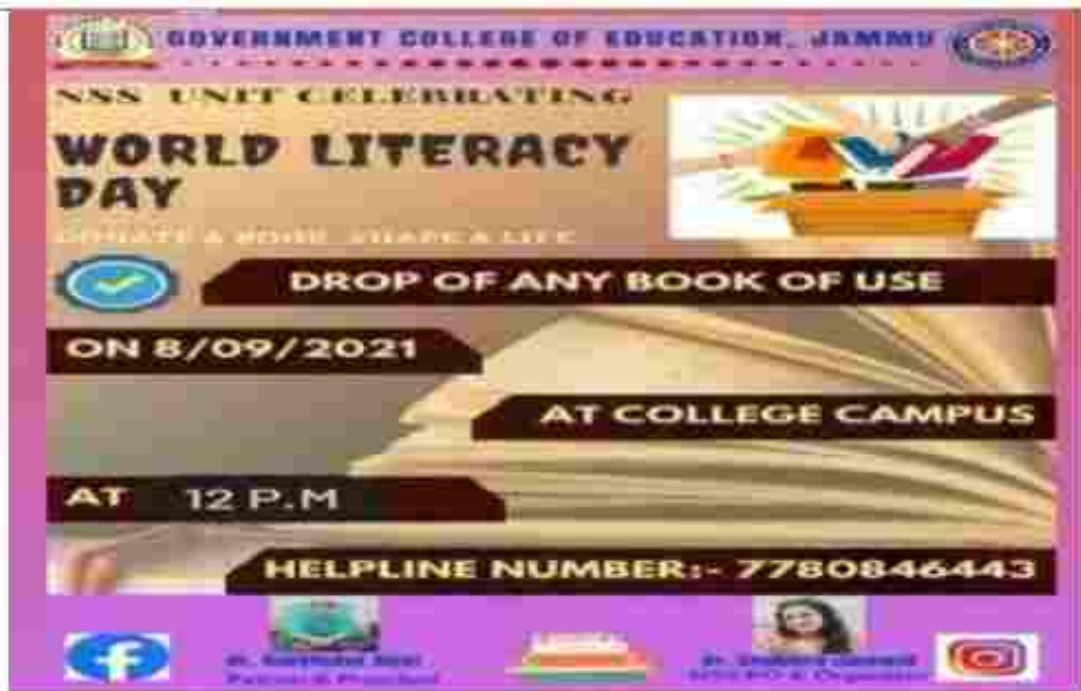


Report on Cleanliness Drive:

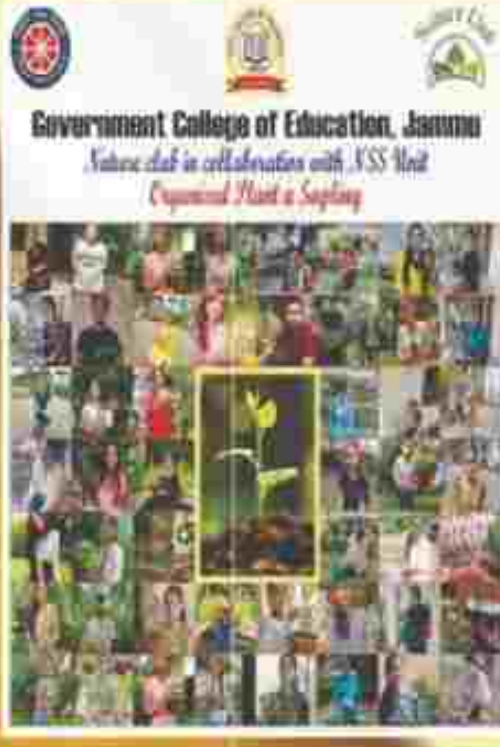


Report on World Democracy Day:
